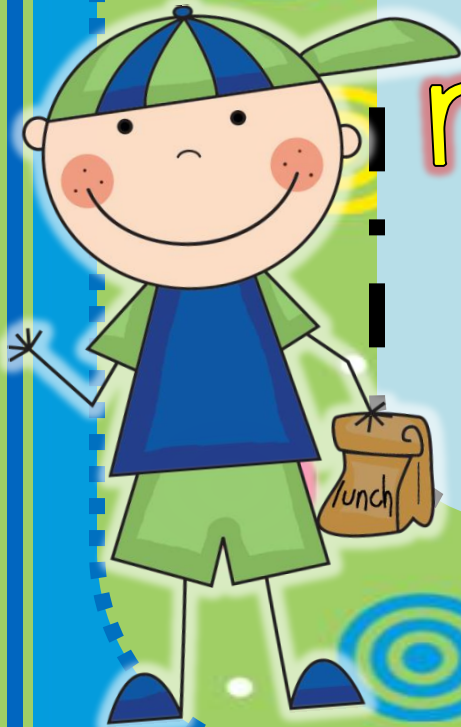

Directions

This activity is intended to be a “get-to-know-you” activity during the first days back to school. It is a guessing game where students will try to guess what another student did over the summer based on his/her clues. Tell students that they will be creating a mask that shows ONE THING they did over the summer. They will draw and color what they did on the front of the mask. On the back, they are to write about it. Students glue both sides together on the plain part and thread their yarn through the mask holes. As they work, remind them to stay quiet as they do not want to give away their secret! Tell students to wear their masks to the carpet. Have them take turns to guess what each person did over the summer. Then, have each student read the back of their mask so everyone knows what they really did!

What I Did This Summer Mystery Mask

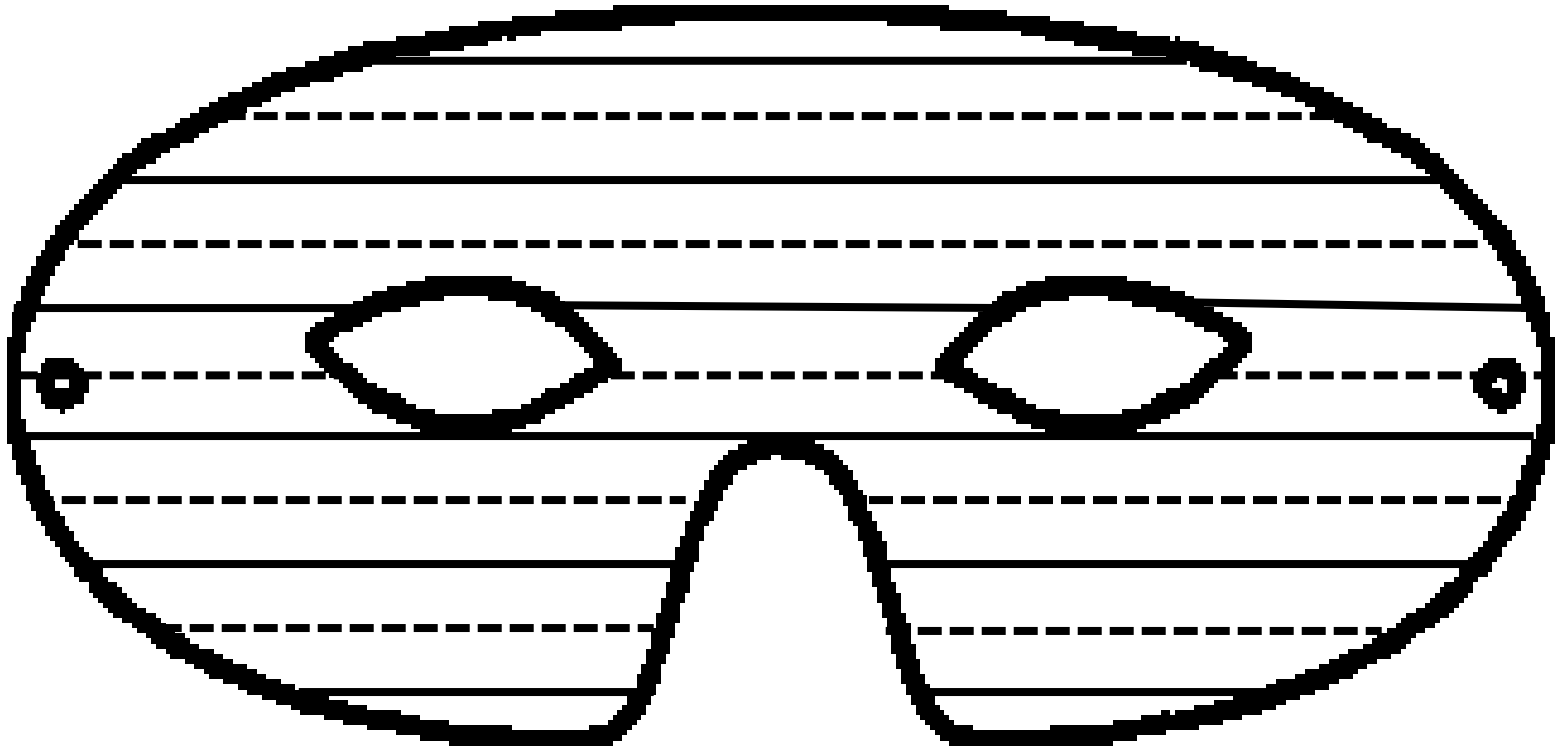
